Preamble:

This memorandum of understanding made on this 1st April 2021 between the "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**".

Witnessed as follows:

RECOGNISING the mutual interest in the fields of research, development, educational training and dissemination of knowledge on long term non-commercial basis, and also,

HEREBY agree to establish collaboration in terms of the field study and analysis during the pendency of MOU according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder,

The words "the two institutions" and "collaborating institutions" in the Memorandum of Understanding refer to the "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**".

Article-1: FIELD OF COLLABORATION:

Collaboration between the two institutions may be established within any field related to science and technology of mutual interest and in particular academics & research. Extension to other areas will be made through further amendments to the present Memorandum of Understanding.

Article-2: EXCHANGE OF STAFF AND STUDENTS:

2.1 Faculty and students of either institute, who wish to undertake a short-term programme or field work/research work at the other institution, will be assisted by the host institution in getting authorization, finding accommodation,

library and laboratory facilities provided the programme is accepted by the home institution and by at least one supervisor from each institution. Faculty and students should have funding for cost of daily living, accommodation, research costs, books, etc.

- 2.2 There is a possibility of twinning faculty and students of the two Institutions in common research.
- 2.3 Parties will exchange proposals concerning the topics, persons, type of research, tests and periods of specific research reasonably in advance of the proposed visit.
- 2.4 The facilities available in the respective institutions shall be extended for the students by mutually agreed terms and conditions.

Article-3: TRAINING

- 3.1 "Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur" will provide facilities for practical training for students of Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora. The training fees, travel and/or living allowances to these students will be provided by Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora or student itself. The selection of the student will be need based.

Similarly students from Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur can also be sent for training to Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora.

Article-4: JOINT SUPERVISION OF STUDENT PROJECT:

- 4.1 As part of collaboration, the faculty of both institutes may jointly supervise research projects of students.
- 4.2 The details for projects of students will be worked out by the respective persons of both institutions.
- 4.3 The student should first submit a project proposal which has to be authorized by both the institutions.
- 4.4 Both the institutes will hold intellectual property rights on any research or project being jointly done.
- 4.5 Publication of the same will be done in joint collaborations.

Article-5: RESEARCH PROJECTS:

- 5.1 Efforts will be made to write and conduct research project by both institutions and provide information about on-going research activities in order to establish contacts and collaboration between professionals working within the same field.
- 5.2 Research projects and the composition of research teams will be approved by the

both institutions. Efforts will be made to evaluate the need for participating staff and the location of the research activity.

- 5.3 Each research project will be jointly led by both institutions team leader, who will be responsible for reporting on the project status.
- 5.4 Both the institutes will hold intellectual property rights on any research or project being jointly done.
- 5.5 Publication of the same will be done in joint collaborations

Article-6: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR):

- 6.1 Information on research results and scientific materials (reports, articles, books, patents) will be exchanged freely by both institutes and mutually agreed provision of Intellectual Property Rights. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by XYZ during the course of this agreement shall be owned by the **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**" during the course of this Agreement shall be owned by them. Intellectual property jointly conceived and/or developed by "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**" will be jointly owned by **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora** and "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**". "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**" Nagpur agree to collaborate towards the protection, if application of such intellectual property for commercial or other purposes on mutually acceptable terms with equal shares.

Article- 7 FUNDING AND FINANCE:

Information on research results and their application and scientific materials will be exchanged free of charge on returnable basis wherever possible

Article-8: LINK MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION:

Negotiation, implementation and co-ordination of the Memorandum of Understanding falls under the responsibility of both, Director, "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**" and the Principal **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**. The Memorandum of Understanding will take effect from the date it is signed by the **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**.

" and Centre Head, "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**".

Article-9: GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- 9.1 The two institutions will carry out joint research as a follow up to this Memorandum of Understanding. The activities must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in country.
- 9.2 The two institutions shall initiate an exchange of research publications, publication lists and other official publications. This will be provided with adequate security as for as intellectual property laws are concerned as mentioned in article No. 6.
- 9.3 All publications resulting from the collaboration between the two institutions will be mentioned in the scientific reports of the institutions. Likewise, this Memorandum of Understanding must also be mentioned in all formal presentations, which result from the collaboration under the terms of this Memorandum of understanding.
- 9.4 This Memorandum of Understanding is signed subject to appropriate authorisation on both sides.

Article 10: "Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur" will have (affiliation) recognized centre to the "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and can initiate technical manpower training courses jointly with DMIMS.

Article-11: NON-DISCLOSURE:

- 11.1 In case of joint research and consultancy projects taken up by "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur", no party will disclose any investigation to media/any unauthorized person from each institute in any form whether electronic/print without mutual consent and approval by coordination Committee.

Article 12: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

Any differences or dispute between the parties concerning the interpretation and /or implementation and/or application of any of the provision of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiation between the Parties. In case, the dispute occurred between both the parties and if the same is not resolved through negotiation or by adopting amicable measures, in that case the matter will be settled through Arbitration and the Arbitrator will be appointed with the mutual consent of both the parties, without reference to any tribunal or court at Nagpur only.

Article-13: VALIDITY PERIOD:

13.1 This MOU shall be valid for a period of five years from the date of signing. At the end of validity period of the MOU, a fresh MOU with similar/modified terms may be considered for signing.

That the Party No. 1 is having its Institute in the Name and style of **Anand Niketan College** located in Chandrapur.

That the Party No. 2 is Government authorized E-Waste recycler and is engaged in the business of disposal of all types of Electrical and Electronics Waste in a systematic & eco-friendly manner.

On the request of Party No. 1 Party No. 2 has agreed to recycle/dispose all types of Electrical and Electronic Waste generated in the premises of party No. 1 on the following terms and conditions:-

1. **The** party No. 2 shall undertake the work of weighing, collection and transportation of E-Waste from their premises to party No. 1 as and when required.
2. **The** Party No. 1 shall deliver to the Party No 2 all the E-Waste material like Electrical and Electronic Appliances, IT hardware equipments and its consumables, Telecom Equipments and switches, Bio Medical Equipments and its spares, other Medical devices, Power chords, Cables, Wires, Chargers or any other device that runs on electricity/battery.
3. **The** Party No 2 shall recycle the total E-Waste Collected from the premises of the Party No. 1 in an Eco-Friendly manner at their unit as per the norms, guidelines and standards set by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and provide a Certificate to the Party No. 1 against the total quantity of material collected and disposed/recycled.
4. **The** Party No. 2 shall ensure that there shall not be any improper disposal or any kind of hazard to the Environment and all the rules and regulations of Maharashtra Pollution Control Board or any other Government authority are being fully adhered with no deviation in the process of E-Waste recycling at their unit.
5. **The** Party NO. 2 agreed to pay the Party No. 1 the charges (Rs 15/Kg) as mutually agreed upon against the total quantity of E-Waste collected from the premises of Party No. 1. A registration fee (Rs 29,500/- GST inclusive) will be paid by Party No. 1 to Party no. 2 for E-waste services.
6. **There** shall not be any change or modification or waiver of any of the terms of this agreement, in case of any changes it shall be effective unless agreed to in writing and signed by duly authorized officer of each of the parties hereto.
7. **This** Agreement between two parties shall be valid from **22nd March 2021, upto 31st March 2025**, and shall be further extended under same terms and conditions for next 2 financial years.
8. **If** any of the party wishes to discontinue this Agreement anytime during the agreed period then one month prior notice needs to be given to the other party.

Report

One Day Virtual Workshop on “Management of Electronics waste and Plastic Waste: An Initiative towards Save Environment” was organized by Department of Zoology on **30th June, 2021** at 12.00 p.m. The objective of workshop was to sensitize, motivate participants and to inculcate habit of proper management of Electronic and Plastic wastes.

Total 127 participants were registered through Google forms. Participants were mostly from different platforms viz Students, Faculty, Research Scholars, Contributory teachers, Project officers, NGOs to enrich the session.

Workshop comprises of two sessions, first session guest speaker was Ms. MahimaSuri, Head of Marketing & Business Development of Suritex Pvt. Ltd. It is the only registered company in Vidarbha which is actively involved in recycling of E-waste in a systematic & eco-friendly manner following the safety norms set by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB). Madam explained the importance of eco-friendly recycling of e-waste with the help of recorded videos. She shared the tips, how we can contribute towards save environment. She motivates the students to collect e-waste from their area and Suritex will purchase it and form a chain regarding e-waste recycling.

In the second session, Ms.Kalpana Chinchkhede, working as a Range Forest Officer, Medicinal Plant Forest Development Corporation of Maharashtra, discussed about plastic waste management. Madam being a good orator, precisely explained how plastic causing impacts to environment (Air, Water, and Soil), human beings and animals. She shared number of experiences, how animals engulf plastic along with food materials, aquatic animals gets entangled in plastic and leads to ailments and mortality etc. For proper disposal of snacks plastic and beverages bottles, Madam showed proper technique of preparing bottle bricks. These bottle bricks are very tough and can be replaced by traditional red bricks. Nowadays bottle bricks are used to prepare walls, furniture, decorative articles.Madam sensitized students about their responsibilities towards the save and healthy environment. Some tips was shared to achieve 3R i.e reduce, reuse and recycle.

Both the sessions was highly appreciated by the participants through Google Feedback forms in reference to content of presentation, quality and understanding the topic. Participants suggested to organize more such programs and drop a wish to be a part for drive “An InitiativeTowards Save Environment”

- Participants learned about 3Rs i.e. reduce, reuse and recycling of wastes
- Participants acquire creative angle of disposing plastic waste by preparing bottle bricks
- Most of the participants are sensitized towards their social responsibilities and they came forward to volunteer the E-waste collection drive



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Preamble:

This memorandum of understanding made on this 1stApril 2021 between the "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaignj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli**".

Witnessed as follows:

RECOGNISING the mutual interest in the fields of research, development, educational training and dissemination of knowledge on long term non-commercial basis, and also, **HEREBY** agree to establish collaboration in terms of the field study and analysis during the pendency of MOU according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder,

The words "the two institutions" and "collaborating institutions" in the Memorandum of Understanding refer to the "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaignj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli**".

Article-1: FIELD OF COLLABORATION:

Collaboration between the two institutions may be established within any field related to science and technology of mutual interest and in particular

academics & research. Extension to other areas will be made through further amendments to the present Memorandum of Understanding.

Article-2: EXCHANGE OF STAFF AND STUDENTS:

- 2.1 Faculty and students of either institute, who wish to undertake a short-term programme or field work/research work at the other institution, will be assisted by the host institution in getting authorization, finding accommodation, library and laboratory facilities provided the programme is accepted by the home institution and by at least one supervisor from each institution. Faculty and students should have funding for cost of daily living, accommodation, research costs, books, etc.
- 2.2 There is a possibility of twinning faculty and students of the two Institutions in common research.
- 2.3 Parties will exchange proposals concerning the topics, persons, type of research, tests and periods of specific research reasonably in advance of the proposed visit.
- 2.4 The facilities available in the respective institutions shall be extended for the students by mutually agreed terms and conditions.

Article-3: TRAINING

- 3.1. "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" will provide facilities for practical training for Faculty and students of "Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaignanj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli" and vice versa. The training fees, travel and/or living allowances to these students will be provided by the Parent institutions or student itself. The selection of the student will be need based.

Article-4: JOINT SUPERVISION OF STUDENT PROJECT:

- 4.1 As part of collaboration, the faculty of both institutes may jointly supervise research projects of students.
- 4.2 The details for projects of students will be worked out by the respective persons of both institutions.
- 4.3 The student should first submit a project proposal which has to be authorized by

- both the institutions.
- 4.4 Both the institutes will hold intellectual property rights on any research or project being jointly done.
- 4.5 Publication of the same will be done in joint collaborations.

Article-5: RESEARCH PROJECTS:

- 5.1 Efforts will be made to write and conduct research project by both institutions and provide information about on-going research activities in order to establish contacts and collaboration between professionals working within the same field.
- 5.2 Research projects and the composition of research teams will be approved by the both institutions. Efforts will be made to evaluate the need for participating staff and the location of the research activity.
- 5.3 Each research project will be jointly led by both institutions team leader, who will be responsible for reporting on the project status.
- 5.4 Both the institutes will hold intellectual property rights on any research or project being jointly done.
- 5.5 Publication of the same will be done in joint collaborations

Article-6: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR):

6.1 Information on research results and scientific materials (reports, articles, books, patents) will be exchanged freely by both institutes and mutually agreed provision of Intellectual Property Rights. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by XYZ during the course of this agreement shall be owned by the **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by **"Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaiganj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli"** during the course of this Agreement shall be owned by them. Intellectual property jointly conceived and/or developed by **"Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora"** and **"Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaiganj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli"** will be jointly owned by **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora** and **"Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaiganj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli"**. **"Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora"** and **"Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaiganj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli"** agree to collaborate towards the protection, if application of such intellectual property for commercial or other purposes on mutually acceptable terms with equal shares.

Article- 7 FUNDING AND FINANCE:

Information on research results and their application and scientific materials will be exchanged free of charge on returnable basis wherever possible.

Article-8: LINK MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION:

Negotiation, implementation and co-ordination of the Memorandum of Understanding falls under the responsibility of both, Principal, "**Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaiganj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli**" and the Principal **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**. The Memorandum of Understanding will take effect from the date it is signed by the **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora.**" and Centre Head, "**Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaiganj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli**".

Article-9: GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- 9.1 The two institutions will carry out joint research as a follow up to this Memorandum of Understanding. The activities must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in country.
- 9.2 The two institutions shall initiate an exchange of research publications, publication lists and other official publications. This will be provided with adequate security as for as intellectual property laws are concerned as mentioned in article No. 6.
- 9.3 All publications resulting from the collaboration between the two institutions will be mentioned in the scientific reports of the institutions. Likewise, this Memorandum of Understanding must also be mentioned in all formal presentations, which result from the collaboration under the terms of this Memorandum of understanding.
- 9.4 This Memorandum of Understanding is signed subject to appropriate authorisation on both sides.

Article 10: "**Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaiganj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli**" will have (affiliation) recognized centre to the "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and can initiate technical manpower training courses jointly with **Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaiganj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli**.

Article-11: NON-DISCLOSURE:

11.1 In case of joint research and consultancy projects taken up by "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Mohsinbhai Zaweri Mahavidyalaya, Desaiganj (Wadsa) Dist- Gadchiroli", no party will disclose any investigation to media/any unauthorized person from each institute in any form whether electronic/print without mutual consent and approval by coordination Committee.





Article 12: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

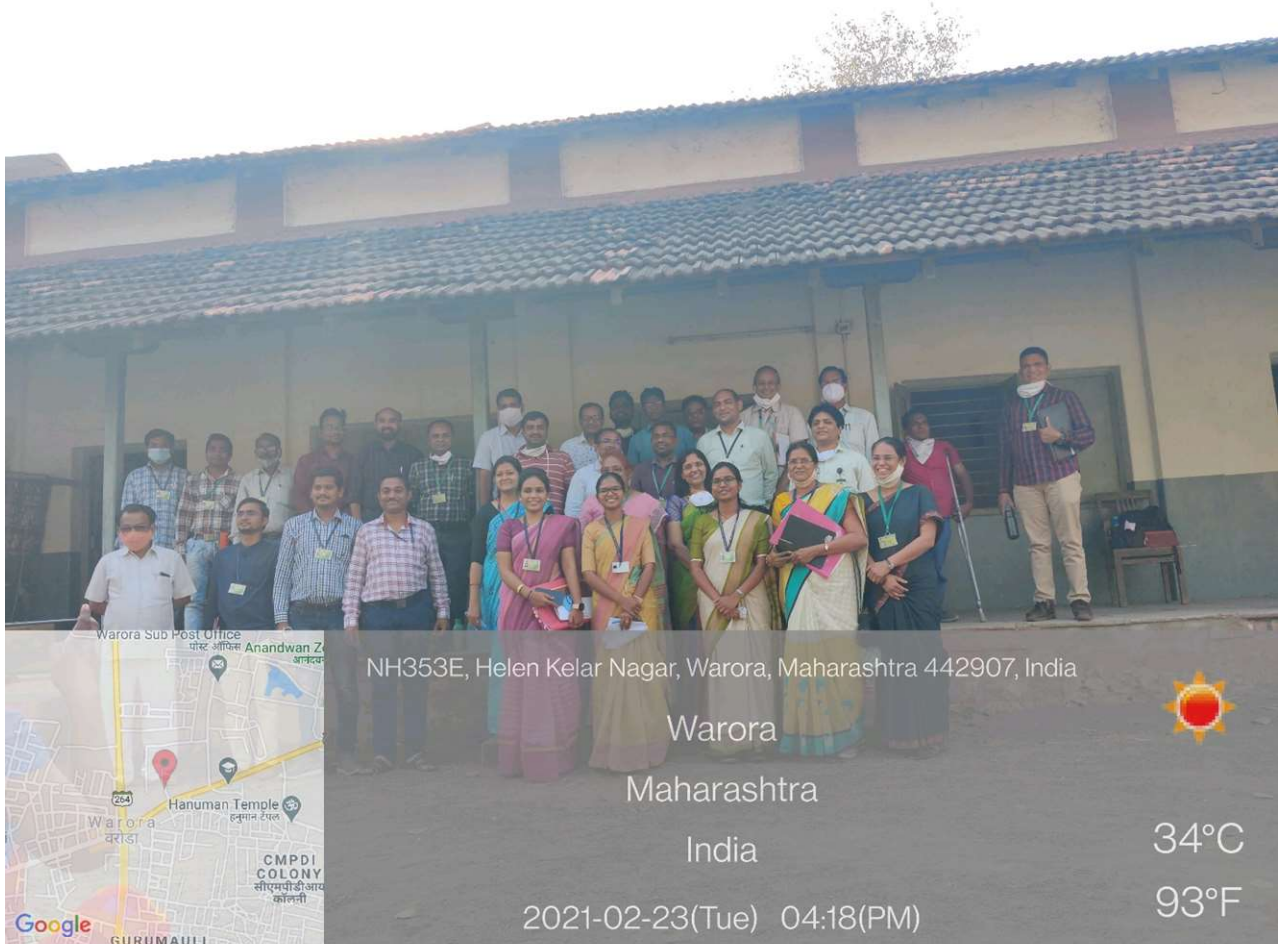

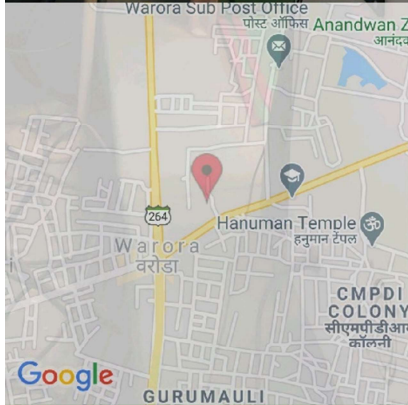
