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- I. Name of the Society: Maharogi Sewa Samiti, Warora
- II. Objects of the Society (Samiti):
 1. To take all possible steps to combat the disease of leprosy.
 2. To establish and conduct leprosy clinics, hospitals, and asylums for lepers and such other institutions as may be useful in the service of leprosy patients.
 - 2.a To establish and conduct general hospitals, Man-Power-Training Centres, Educational activities and institutions, training and rehabilitation centres for the blind, physically handicapped, mentally retarded and similar other activities like tribal and youth welfare, orphanages, and such other institutions as may be found useful in the service and fulfillment of the above objects of the M.S. Samiti (Society). (Objects expanded vide M.S. Samiti's resolution unanimously passed in special general meeting dated 29-12-1968, following the procedure prescribed u/s 12 of Societies Registration Act, XXI of 1960 (Central).
 - 2b To undertake any other activity or activities of rural development anywhere including the tribal areas, to undertake community health programmes and to organize the Centres for Social Action. (Objects expanded vide M.S. Samiti's resolution passed unanimously in its special general meeting held on 26-12-78).
 - 2c.
 - i. To promote and conduct scientific research and training in community medicine with special reference to leprology and its all aspects and Rehabilitational Sciences with special emphasis on occupational and physical rehabilitation of physically and mentally handicapped of all categories.
 - ii. To promote and conduct scientific research in rural and tribal development with special reference to marginal dry land farming, welfare of tribals and socially retarded groups and conservation of natural resources, environment and social forestry etc.

- 2.c. (iii) To stimulate people's involvement and organise community action in the fields of social, economic and cultural development.
- (iv) To engage in the education of rural poor for development activities.
- (v) To undertake study and research in all matters pertaining to community development.
- (vi) To undertake and participate in programmes pertaining to health education in the field of community development.
- (vii) To appoint an advisory board of persons whether members of M.S. Samiti or not, not exceeding nine for the purpose of carrying out the objectives, research and the functions of the M.S. Samiti and render to them such fees or remuneration or travelling expenses or such proportion thereof as the M.S. Samiti in its discretion considers expedient. This fee or remuneration should be decided by the General Body of M.S. Samiti. However, its recommendations will not be obligatory on the M.S. Samiti.
- (viii) To conduct and/or participate in seminars, study circles, camps, field trips, lectures, conferences, surveys, research and training programmes, audio-visual and mass media services, exhibitions, literary conferences and publication of literature in accordance with an in furtherance of the various objectives of this Samiti. (Objectives expanded vide M.S. Samiti's resolution passed unanimously in its special general meeting held on 27-11-1983).
3. To raise funds and acquire and hold property for the same.
4. To do all things necessary for the fulfillment of the above objectives of the Society (Samiti).

7. The Governing Body of the Samiti shall have powers to make by laws, in so far as they are not repugnant to the rules and regulations for the time being in force, shall have the same force and vailidity as the Rules and Regulations of the Samiti.
8. The members present by choose one of their members to act as Chairman of the meeting.
9. The year of the samiti shall be the Financial year is from 1st April to 31st March (Amended vide Resolution passed in the Annual Meeting of M.S.Samiti on 2-5-1956).
10. ANNUAL MEETING :-
There shall be held in every year an annual meeting of the Samiti to be called the Annual General Meeting at which the following business shall be transacted :-
- (a) To received and consider the report of the affairs of the Samiti during the preceding year.
 - (b) To consider and the pass the audited account and the Balance Sheet of the preceding year.
 - (c) To elect the office bearers and other members of the Governing Body if and when necessary, according to the provisions of Rules and the Regulations.
 - (d) To consider any other matter that may be placed before it by the Secretary or with the permission of the Chairman by any other member.
11. EXTRA ORDINARY MEETINGS.
Extra Ordinary General Meeting of the Samiti may be held as and when necessary or on the requisitation of five members of the Samiti.
12. MEETINGS OF THE GOVERNING BODY
Meetings of the Governing Body of the Samiti may be held as and when necessary or on the requisitation of three members of the Governing Body.
13. TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING :-
The time and place of the Annual and Extra-ordinary General Meetings of the Samiti and all Meetings of the Governing Body shall be fixed by the Secretary unless the Governing Body in any case decides otherwise.
14. REQUISITIONS BY THE MEMBERS.
All the requisitions by the members for the meeting of the Samiti or of the Governing Body shall be in writing, signed by the requisitionists and shall contain the objects of the proposed meeting. If the Secretary fails to call a meeting within one month from the date of the receipt of the requisition, the requisitionists will be entitled to a meeting at the Head Office of the Samiti within two months from the date of the receipt of requisition by the Secretary. Any meeting called under this provision shall be called in the same manner as nearly as possible as that in which other meeting are called by the Secretary.
15. Unless specially provided for by the satute or the Rules and Regulations of the Samiti, all matters comming before the Samiti shall be decided by a majority of votes. In case of equality of votes, The Secretary will have the casting vots. For all



16. The funds of the samiti may be deposited in such Bank, or Banks or invested in such manner as may be decided from time to time by the Governing Body.
17. All property movable or immovable, belonging to the Samiti shall vest in the Governing Body for the time being of the Samiti. All deeds and documents on behalf of the Samiti may be executed or be got executed by the Secretary or such other person as may be authorised for the purpose by the Governing Body.
18. The Secretary shall be competent to sue or be sued on behalf of the Samiti.
19. POWER TO ACT INSPITE OF VACANCY :-
The Samiti and the Governing Body shall have power to act and be deemed to be duly constituted not with standing any vacancy in their membership.
20. The Samiti may alter or add to any of its Rules and Regulations by the majority of three-fifths of the members present at the meeting such majority not being less than half of all the members of the Samiti.
21. Decision on any matter which the Secretary considers urgent may be taken by the circulars to the members, where at least half the number of members has given assent and provided that there is no dissentient opinion from any member.
22. The Secretary ^{may} at any time appoint an Assistant Secretary and may delegate to the Assistant Secretary all such power for the management of the affairs of the Samiti as he considers necessary. (Resolution passed in Meeting of M.S.S. on 1-11-1968.)
23. The Special Annual Meeting shall be called every year to pass the budget of the Samiti, before February of every year. (Added vide Resolution No. 8 (a) in Annual General Meeting dated 24-10-1982).
