

Student Satisfaction Survey 2021-2022






What degree program are you pursuing now?




What subject area are you currently pursuing?




How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 662 responses




How well did the teachers prepare for the classes? 662 responses




How well were the teachers able to communicate? 662 responses




The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 662 responses



Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers 662 responses




Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 662 responses








The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social andemotional growth.




















