



That the Party No. 1 is having its Institute in the Name and style of Anand Niketan College located in Chandrapur.

That the Party No. 2 is Government authorized E-Waste recycler and is engaged in the business of disposal of all types of Electrical and Electronics Waste in a systematic & eco-friendly manner.

On the request of Party No. 1 Party No. 2 has agreed to recycle/dispose all types of Electrical and Electronic Waste generated in the premises of party No. 1 on the following terms and conditions:-

- 1. The party No. 2 shall undertake the work of weighing, collection and transportation of E-Waste from their premises to party No. 1 as and when required.
- 2. The Party No. 1 shall deliver to the Party No 2 all the E-Waste material like Electrical and Electronic Appliances, IT hardware equipments and its consumables, Telecom Equipments and switches, Bio Medical Equipments and its spares, other Medical devices, Power chords, Cables, Wires, Chargers or any other device that runs on electricity/battery.
- **3.** The Party No 2 shall recycle the total E-Waste Collected from the premises of the Party No. 1 in an Eco-Friendly manner at their unit as per the norms, guidelines and standards set by Maharashtra Pollution Control Board and provide a Certificate to the Party No. 1 against the total quantity of material collected and disposed/recycled.
- **4.** The Party No. 2 shall ensure that there shall not be any improper disposal or any kind of hazard to the Environment and all the rules and regulations of Maharashtra Pollution Control Board or any other Government authority are being fully adhered with no deviation in the process of E-Waste recycling at their unit.
- 5. The Party NO. 2 agreed to pay the Party No. 1 the charges (Rs 15/Kg) as mutually agreed upon against the total quantity of E-Waste collected from the premises of Party No. 1. A registration fee (Rs 29,500/- GST inclusive) will be paid by Party No. 1 to Party no. 2 for E-waste services.
- 6. There shall not be any change or modification or waiver of any of the terms of this agreement, in case of any changes it shall be effective unless agreed to in writing and signed by duly authorized officer of each of the parties hereto.
- This Agreement between two parties shall be valid from 22nd March 2021, upto 31st March 2025, and shall be further extended under same terms and conditions for next 2 financial years.
- If any of the party wishes to discontinue this Agreement anytime during the agreed period then one month prior notice needs to be given to the other party.

Report

One Day Virtual Workshop on "Management of Electronics waste and Plastic Waste: An Initiative towards Save Environment" was organized by Department of Zoology on 30th June, 2021 at 12.00 p.m. The objective of workshop was to sensitize, motivate participants and to inculcate habit of proper management of Electronic and Plastic wastes.

Total 127 participants were registered through Google forms. Participants were mostly from different platforms viz Students, Faculty, Research Scholars, Contributory teachers, Project officers, NGOs to enrich the session.

Workshop comprises of two sessions, first session guest speaker was Ms. MahimaSuri, Head of Marketing & Business Development of Suritex Pvt. Ltd. It is the only registered company in Vidarbha which is actively involved in recycling of E-waste in a systematic & eco-friendly manner following the safety norms set by the Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB). Madam explained the importance of eco-friendly recycling of e-waste with the help of recorded videos. She shared the tips, how we can contribute towards save environment. She motivates the students to collect e-waste from their area and Suritex will purchase it and form a chain regarding e-waste recycling.

In the second session, Ms.Kalpana Chinchkhede, working as a Range Forest Officer, Medicinal Plant Forest Development Corporation of Maharashtra, discussed about plastic waste management. Madam being a good orator, precisely explained how plastic causing impacts to environment (Air, Water, and Soil), human beings and animals. She shared number of experiences, how animals engulf plastic along with food materials, aquatic animals gets entangled in plastic and leads to ailments and mortality etc. For proper disposal of snacks plastic and beverages bottles, Madam showed proper technique of preparing bottle bricks. These bottle bricks are very tough and can be replaced by traditional red bricks. Nowadays bottle bricks are used to prepare walls, furniture, decorative articles.Madam sensitized students about their responsibilities towards the save and healthy environment. Some tips was shared to achieve 3R i.e reduce, reuse and recycle.

Both the sessions was highly appreciated by the participants through Google Feedback forms in reference to content of presentation, quality and understanding the topic. Participants suggested to organize more such programs and drop a wish to be a part for drive "An InitiativeTowards Save Environment"

Programme Outcome:

- Participants able to understand about hazardous impacts of Electronic and plastic towards their health as well as environment and animals.
- Participants learned about 3Rs i.e. reduce, reuse and recycling of wastes
- Participants acquire creative angle of disposing plastic waste by preparing bottle bricks
- Most of the participants are sensitized towards their social responsibilities and they came forward to volunteer the E-waste collection drive
