MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

Anand Niketan College Anandwan,

Warora, Dist. Chandrapur.

AND COUNCIL FOR TEACHERS EDUCATION (CTE)

Maharashtra Chapter.

This MoU, with regard to a formal collaboration between "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Council for Teachers Education (CTE), Maharashtra Chapter" for conducting Training on Faculty & Student Development is made on this 15th day of September, 2021.

Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora, Dist. Chandrapur, Maharashtra, India, established in 1964 by Maharogi Sewa Samiti, Warora (hereinafter referred to as ANC which expression shall where the contexts so requests or admits, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigners)

And

Council for Teachers Education (CTE), Maharashtra Chapter, a society registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1860, having its registered office of Maharashtra at Pune (hereinafter referred to as CTE which expression shall where the context so requests or admits, be deemed to include its successors its and permitted assignees)

Together both of them to be referred to as the "Parties" and each a "party".

Objective:

ANC and CTE are entering into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for a formal collaboration to conduct training jointly by CTE and ANC on different aspects of Student & Faculty Development.

Now it is hereby mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as under.

1. Aspects of Student & Faculty Training:

- Training program will be organised on chargeable and free of cost basis from the trainees.
- Training would be of different duration.
- Both theoretical and practical training will be organised.
- One or two visits to hereby scientific institutes will be organised.
- Training shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and approval of the competent authority of ANC and CTE.
- There will be feedback system from the trainees
- Participation certificates will be issued to all trainees.

2. Responsibilities of the parties:

a) Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora.

- Selecting of the topic of training for Student & Faculty.
- Popularizing Training schedule by uploading the Advertisement Flyer in ANC website and sending to known institutes and individual for larger participation.
- Deciding the training fees and collecting the same from the participants.
- Providing logistic support i.e. arranging boarding and lodging, transport for the trainees, faculties and other officials out of the funds sanctioned by CTE.
- Selecting faculties from ANC and other HEI's in consultation with CTE.
- Selecting the venue for the training in consultation with CTE.
- Overall management of the training programme including arranging stationeries, printing of documents, etc.

b) Role of CTE

- Selecting of the topic of training for Students & Faculty.
- Designing the Training Module.
- Deciding training dates and duration of the training in consultation with ANC.
- Identification of Faculties from CTE, Industry and other experts.
- Identification of potential trainees from Government, Private and Civil Society bodies.
- Preparation of Advertisement flyer for the training and popularized in different forums.
- Deciding the maximum number of trainees that can be accommodated in one training programme.
- Deciding the training fees and collecting the same from the participants.
- Making funds available to ANC for making arrangements/ logistics for the programme.
- Preparation of training materials.



3. Representatives of the parties

Each party will be appointing their respective Nodal officer/ Training coordinator towards coordination, sharing of information, data, knowledge, etc. with other party for smooth conduct of the training.

4. Duration and Termination

The memorandum of understanding (MoU) shall remain in force for a period of **Five** years from the date it is signed by the authorized signatories of both parties. It may further be extended or amended by executing written amendatory agreement between the parties.

This MoU may be terminated by either party subject to the delivery of three months advance notice, in writing. In the event of termination or expiry of this MoU, any obligations and commitments undertaken earlier shall be performed by the parties until full completion unless agreed otherwise by both the parties in writing.

5. Monitoring

At ANC, the Principal, will oversee the implementation of the MoU. At CTE, President/Secretary or his nominee will oversee the implementation of the MoU.

6. Financial Provisions

- Total cost of the training will be recovered from the trainees and will be collected by ANC or CTE.
- Each Faculty/Resource persons will be paid honorarium as per the budgetary provision of training programme.
- TA/DA of all external faculties and other officials will be met from the training project cost.






* *A prior estimate of the activity will have to be approved by ANC and CTE.*

7. Amendments

This MoU may be amended and supplemented at any time by executing written agreement by both parties.

8. Final Provisions

The parties consider this MoU as a declaration of intent rather than a legally or financially binding document on conducting trainings. They also proceed from the fact that nothing herein, therefore, shall diminish the full authority of either party to cooperate with third parties and conduct joint projects. This memorandum of understanding has been drawn up in two identical copies one can copy for each party.





This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into by and between “**Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology (VNIT), Nagpur, India**” and the, “**AnandNiketan College (ANC), Anandwan, Warora, India**”. The entities listed above may collectively be referred to as the parties to this MOU.

Article 1. SCOPE and PURPOSE

The main purpose of this MOU is to Promote an institutional linkage between VNIT and ANC and to explore avenues for possible collaboration in research and training of stakeholders broadly in the area Science, Engineering and Technology in which expertise exists and can be mentored by either or both of the two organizations.

Article 2: DURATION

This MOU will be in effect from the date of signing and remain in force until **Three Years** or until such time as proper notification, no less than 60 days in advance, is given by one or both of the parties of the intent to terminate or to modify the institutional relationship. The MOU may be renewed after three years depending upon the satisfactory review of progress/execution.

Article 3: ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Both parties agree on the followings:

1. To designate contact person(s) to facilitate the contacts and progress of the Work.
2. Implementing joint projects and sharing experiences:
 - i. To jointly prepare project proposals and submit to the relevant national and international funding agencies on mutually agreed subjects in Science & Technology to implement the approved projects by using capacities of both parties.
 - ii. To exchange faculty, experts and students for sharing knowledge and experiences for shorter or longer research visits.
3. Collaborate in education of students and young scientists:
 - i. The respective faculty members of ANC and faculty members of VNIT will together formulate the syllabi for academic programmes, new courses, joint research projects and provide training for skill-oriented human resource development of the stakeholder within the areas of co-operation, faculty/research scholar exchange program, joint training programmes/workshops etc.
 - ii. The ANC may as well provide external guidance to two/three students at the B.Tech, M.Tech and/or M.Sc. level.
 - iii. Summer/Winter Internship Program: This MOU will provide opportunities to the students of VNIT to pursue Internship Program at ANC and students of ANC will also get an opportunity for internship in VNIT Guest Faculty/Visiting Faculty: VNIT will invite experts from ANC to share their experience with students of VNIT by delivering lectures on a mutually agreeable topic, date and time.
 - iv. Settlement of Dispute: Any dispute arising out of work related to this MOU will be settled through mutual discussion.
 - v. Force Majeure: The parties shall not be held liable for any breach of terms and conditions under this MOU, when such breach results from a Force Majeure event. This MOU is not intended to create any legal obligations but rather is intended to foster genuine and mutually beneficial academic and research collaboration.

Separate agreements will be prepared and signed by both parties in case that a project proposal succeeds and receives funding. The exact terms and conditions of future co-operation will be deliberated and documented in more specific national/international collaboration agreements.



Preamble:

Witnessed as follows:

RECOGNISING the mutual interest in the fields of research, development, educational training and dissemination of knowledge on long term non-commercial basis, and also,

HEREBY agree to establish collaboration in terms of the field study and analysis during the pendency of MOU according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder,

The words "the two institutions" and "collaborating institutions" in the Memorandum of Understanding refer to the "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur".

- 4.2 The details for projects of students will be worked out by the respective persons of both institutions.

- 5.3 Each research project will be jointly led by both institutions team leader, who will be responsible for reporting on the project status.
- 5.4 Both the institutes will hold intellectual property rights on any research or project being jointly done.
- 5.5 Publication of the same will be done in joint collaborations

Article-6: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR):

6.1 Information on research results and scientific materials (reports, articles, books, patents) will be exchanged freely by both institutes and mutually agreed provision of Intellectual Property Rights. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by XYZ during the course of this agreement shall be owned by the **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by "**Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur**" during the course of this Agreement shall be owned by them. Intellectual property jointly conceived and/or developed by "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur**" will be jointly owned by **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora** and "**Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur**". "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Dada**

Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur agree to collaborate towards the protection, if application of such intellectual property for commercial or other purposes on mutually acceptable terms with equal shares.

Article- 7 FUNDING AND FINANCE:

Information on research results and their application and scientific materials will be exchanged free of charge on returnable basis wherever possible.

Article-8: LINK MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION:

Negotiation, implementation and co-ordination of the Memorandum of Understanding falls under the responsibility of both, Principal, **"Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur"** and the Principal **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**. The Memorandum of Understanding will take effect from the date it is signed by the **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora.** and Centre Head, **"Dada Ramchand Bakhru Sindhu Mahavidyalaya, Nagpur"**.

Article-9: GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- 9.1 The two institutions will carry out joint research as a follow up to this Memorandum of Understanding. The activities must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in country.

Article 12: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

Any differences or dispute between the parties concerning the interpretation and /or implementation and/or application of any of the provision of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiation between the Parties. In case, the dispute occurred between both the parties and if the same is not resolved through negotiation or by adopting amicable measures, in that case the matter will be settled through Arbitration and the Arbitrator will be appointed with the mutual consent of both the parties, without reference to any tribunal or court at Nagpur only.

11. **Term:** This MoU shall be effective from the date of signing the document & will be valid for 5 years. Either party may terminate this MOU at any time by providing one (1) month written notice to the other party.

This MoU is not legally binding to either of the parties and does not subject them to any liabilities for the breach of contract, whether material or minor of contract or any other liability under the national applicable law.



RECOGNISING the mutual interest in the fields of research, development, educational training and dissemination of knowledge on long term non-commercial basis, and also,

HEREBY agree to establish collaboration in terms of the field study and analysis during the pendency of MOU according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder,

The words "the two institutions" and "collaborating institutions" in the Memorandum of Understanding refer to the "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur".

Article-1: FIELD OF COLLABORATION:

Collaboration between the two institutions may be established within any field related to science and technology of mutual interest and in particular academics & research. Extension to other areas will be made through further amendments to the present Memorandum of Understanding.

Article-2: EXCHANGE OF STAFF AND STUDENTS:

- 2.3 Parties will exchange proposals concerning the topics, persons, type of research, tests and periods of specific research reasonably in advance of the proposed visit.
- 2.4 The facilities available in the respective institutions shall be extended for the students by mutually agreed terms and conditions.

Article-3: TRAINING

- 3.1 "Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur" will provide facilities for practical training for students of Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora. The training fees, travel and/or living allowances to these students will be provided by Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora or student itself. The selection of the student will be need based.

Similarly students from Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur can also be sent for training to Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora.

Article-4: JOINT SUPERVISION OF STUDENT PROJECT:

- 4.1 As part of collaboration, the faculty of both institutes may jointly supervise research projects of students.
- 4.2 The details for projects of students will be worked out by the respective persons of both institutions.
- 4.3 The student should first submit a project proposal which has to be authorized by both the institutions.
- 4.4 Both the institutes will hold intellectual property rights on any research or project being jointly done.
- 4.5 Publication of the same will be done in joint collaborations.

Article-5: RESEARCH PROJECTS:

- 5.1 Efforts will be made to write and conduct research project by both institutions and provide information about on-going research activities in order to establish contacts and collaboration between professionals working within the same field.
- 5.2 Research projects and the composition of research teams will be approved by the

both institutions. Efforts will be made to evaluate the need for participating staff and the location of the research activity.

- 5.3 Each research project will be jointly led by both institutions team leader, who will be responsible for reporting on the project status.
- 5.4 Both the institutes will hold intellectual property rights on any research or project being jointly done.
- 5.5 Publication of the same will be done in joint collaborations

Article-6: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR):

- 6.1 Information on research results and scientific materials (reports, articles, books, patents) will be exchanged freely by both institutes and mutually agreed provision of Intellectual Property Rights. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by XYZ during the course of this agreement shall be owned by the **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**" during the course of this Agreement shall be owned by them. Intellectual property jointly conceived and/or developed by "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**" will be jointly owned by **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora** and "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**". "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**" Nagpur agree to collaborate towards the protection, if application of such intellectual property for commercial or other purposes on mutually acceptable terms with equal shares.

Article- 7 FUNDING AND FINANCE:

Information on research results and their application and scientific materials will be exchanged free of charge on returnable basis wherever possible

Article-8: LINK MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION:

Negotiation, implementation and co-ordination of the Memorandum of Understanding falls under the responsibility of both, Director, "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**" and the Principal **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**. The Memorandum of Understanding will take effect from the date it is signed by the **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**.

" and Centre Head, "**Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur**".

Article-9: GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- 9.1 The two institutions will carry out joint research as a follow up to this Memorandum of Understanding. The activities must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in country.

Likewise, this Memorandum of Understanding must also be mentioned in all formal presentations, which result from the collaboration under the terms of this Memorandum of understanding.
- 9.4 This Memorandum of Understanding is signed subject to appropriate authorisation on both sides.

Article 10: "Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur" will have (affiliation) recognized centre to the "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and can initiate technical manpower training courses jointly with DMIMS.

Article-11: NON-DISCLOSURE:

- 11.1 In case of joint research and consultancy projects taken up by "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Datta Meghe Institute of Management Studies, Nagpur", no party will disclose any investigation to media/any unauthorized person from each institute in any form whether electronic/print without mutual consent and approval by coordination Committee.

Article 12: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

Any differences or dispute between the parties concerning the interpretation and /or implementation and/or application of any of the provision of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiation between the Parties. In case, the dispute occurred between both the parties and if the same is not resolved through negotiation or by adopting amicable measures, in that case the matter will be settled through Arbitration and the Arbitrator will be appointed with the mutual consent of both the parties, without reference to any tribunal or court at Nagpur only.

Preamble:

This memorandum of understanding made on this 1st April 2021 between the "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur".

Witnessed as follows:

RECOGNISING the mutual interest in the fields of research, development, educational training and dissemination of knowledge on long term non-commercial basis, and also, **HEREBY** agree to establish collaboration in terms of the field study and analysis during the pendency of MOU according to terms and conditions set out in the articles following hereunder,

The words "the two institutions" and "collaborating institutions" in the Memorandum of Understanding refer to the "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur".

Article-1: FIELD OF COLLABORATION:

Collaboration between the two institutions may be established within any field related to science and technology of mutual interest and in particular academics & research. Extension to other areas will be made through further amendments to the present Memorandum of Understanding.

Article-2: EXCHANGE OF STAFF AND STUDENTS:

2.1 Faculty and students of either institute, who wish to undertake a short-

term programme or field work/research work at the other institution, will be assisted by the host institution in getting authorization, finding accommodation, library and laboratory facilities provided the programme is accepted by the home institution and by at least one supervisor from each institution. Faculty and students should have funding for cost of daily living, accommodation, research costs, books, etc.

2.2 There is a possibility of twinning faculty and students of the two Institutions in common research.

2.3 Parties will exchange proposals concerning the topics, persons, type of research, tests and periods of specific research reasonably in advance of the proposed visit.

2.4 The facilities available in the respective institutions shall be extended for the students by mutually agreed terms and conditions.

Article-3: TRAINING

3.1. "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" will provide facilities for practical training for Faculty and students of "Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur" and vice versa. The training fees, travel and/or living allowances to these students will be provided by the Parent institutions or student itself. The selection of the student will be need based.

Article-4: JOINT SUPERVISION OF STUDENT PROJECT:

4.1 As part of collaboration, the faculty of both institutes may jointly supervise

research projects of students.

- 4.2 The details for projects of students will be worked out by the respective persons of both institutions.
- 4.3 The student should first submit a project proposal which has to be authorized by both the institutions.
- 4.4 Both the institutes will hold intellectual property rights on any research or project being jointly done.
- 4.5 Publication of the same will be done in joint collaborations.

Article-5: RESEARCH PROJECTS:

- 5.1 Efforts will be made to write and conduct research project by both institutions and provide information about on-going research activities in order to establish contacts and collaboration between professionals working within the same field.
- 5.2 Research projects and the composition of research teams will be approved by the both institutions. Efforts will be made to evaluate the need for participating staff and the location of the research activity.
- 5.3 Each research project will be jointly led by both institutions team leader, who will be responsible for reporting on the project status.
- 5.4 Both the institutes will hold intellectual property rights on any research or project being jointly done.
- 5.5 Publication of the same will be done in joint collaborations

Article-6: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR):

- 6.1 Information on research results and scientific materials (reports, articles, books, patents) will be exchanged freely by both institutes and mutually agreed provision of Intellectual Property Rights. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by XYZ during the course of this agreement shall be owned by the **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by "**Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur**" during the course of this Agreement shall be owned by them. Intellectual property jointly conceived and/or developed by "**Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora**" and "**Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur**" will be jointly owned by **Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora** and "**Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering,**

Nagpur". "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur" Nagpur agree to collaborate towards the protection, if application of such intellectual property for commercial or other purposes on mutually acceptable terms with equal shares.




Article- 7 FUNDING AND FINANCE:

Information on research results and their application and scientific materials will be exchanged free of charge on returnable basis wherever possible.

Article-8: LINK MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION:

Negotiation, implementation and co-ordination of the Memorandum of Understanding falls under the responsibility of both, Principal, "Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur" and the Principal Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora. The Memorandum of Understanding will take effect from the date it is signed by the Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora." and Centre Head, "Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur".

Article-9: GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- 
- 9.1 The two institutions will carry out joint research as a follow up to this Memorandum of Understanding. The activities must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in country.
 - 9.2 The two institutions shall initiate an exchange of research publications, publication lists and other official publications. This will be provided with adequate security as for as intellectual property laws are concerned as mentioned in article No. 6.
 - 9.3 All publications resulting from the collaboration between the two institutions will be mentioned in the scientific reports of the institutions. Likewise, this Memorandum of Understanding must also be mentioned in all formal presentations, which result from the collaboration under the terms of this Memorandum of understanding.
 - 9.4 This Memorandum of Understanding is signed subject to appropriate authorisation on both sides.

Article 10: "Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur" will have (affiliation)

recognized centre to the "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and can initiate technical manpower training courses jointly with Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur.

Article-11: NON-DISCLOSURE:

11.1 In case of joint research and consultancy projects taken up by "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Priyadarshini J. L. College of Engineering, Nagpur", no party will disclose any investigation to media/any unauthorized person from each institute in any form whether electronic/print without mutual consent and approval by coordination Committee.

Article 12: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

Any differences or dispute between the parties concerning the interpretation and /or implementation and/or application of any of the provision of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiation between the Parties. In case, the dispute occurred between both the parties and if the same is not resolved through negotiation or by adopting amicable measures, in that case the matter will be settled through Arbitration and the Arbitrator will be appointed with the mutual consent of both the parties, without reference to any tribunal or court at Nagpur only.

Article-13: VALIDITY PERIOD:

13.1 This MOU shall be valid for a period of five years from the date of signing. At the end of validity period of the MOU, a fresh MOU with similar/modified terms may be considered for signing.

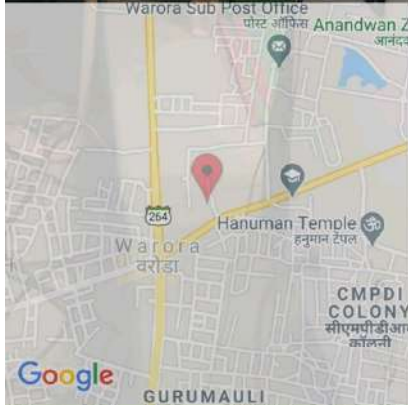
