# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) BETWEEN

Anand Niketan College Anandwan,

Warora, Dist. Chandrapur.

#### AND COUNCIL FOR TEACHERS EDUCATION (CTE)

Maharashtra Chapter.

This MoU, with regard to a formal collaboration between "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora" and "Council for Teachers Education (CTE), Maharashtra Chapter" for conducting Training on Faculty & Student Development is made on this 15<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2021.

Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora, Dist. Chandrapur, Maharashtra, India, established in 1964 by Maharogi Sewa Samiti, Warora (hereinafter referred to as ANC which expression shall where the contexts so requests or admits, be deemed to include its successors and permitted assigners)

And

Council for Teachers Education (CTE), Maharashtra Chapter, a society registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1860, having its registered office of Maharashtra at Pune (hereinafter referred to as CTE which expression shall where the context so requests or admits, be deemed to include its successors its and permitted assignees)

Together both of them to be referred to as the "Parties" and each a "party".

Objective:

ANC and CTE are entering into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for a formal collaboration to conduct training jointly by CTE and ANC on different aspects of Student & Faculty Development.

Now it is hereby mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as under.

#### 1. Aspects of Student & Faculty Training:

- Training program will be organised on chargeable and free of cost basis from the trainees.
- Training would be of different duration.
- Both theoretical and practical training will be organised.
- One or two visits to hereby scientific institutes will be organised.
- Training shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and approval of the competent authority of ANC and CTE.
- There will be feedback system from the trainees
- Participation certificates will be issued to all trainees.

#### 2. Responsibilities of the parties:

#### a) Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora.

- Selecting of the topic of training for Student & Faculty.
- Popularizing Training schedule by uploading the Advertisement Flyer in ANC website and sending to known institutes and individual for larger participation.
- Deciding the training fees and collecting the same from the participants.
- Providing logistic support i.e. arranging boarding and lodging, transport for the trainees, faculties and other officials out of the funds sanctioned by CTE.
- Selecting faculties from ANC and other HEI's in consultation with CTE.
- Selecting the venue for the training in consultation with CTE.
- Overall management of the training programme including arranging stationeries, printing of documents, etc.

#### b) Role of CTE

- Selecting of the topic of training for Students & Faculty.
- Designing the Training Module.
- Deciding training dates and duration of the training in consultation with ANC.
- Identification of Faculties from CTE, Industry and other experts.
- Identification of potential trainees from Government, Private and Civil Society bodies.
- Preparation of Advertisement flyer for the training and popularized in different forums.
- Deciding the maximum number of trainees that can be accommodated in one training programme.
- Deciding the training fees and collecting the same from the participants.
- Making funds available to ANC for making arrangements/ logistics for the programme.
- Preparation of training materials.



3. Representatives of the parties

Each party will be appointing their respective Nodal officer/ Training coordinator towards coordination, sharing of information, data, knowledge, etc. with other party for smooth conduct of the training.

#### 4. Duration and Termination

The memorandum of understanding (MoU) shall remain in force for a period of **Five** years from the date it is signed by the authorized signatories of both parties. It may further be extended or amended by executing written amendatory agreement between the parties.

This MoU may be terminated by either party subject to the delivery of three months advance notice, in writing. In the event of termination or expiry of this MoU, any obligations and commitments undertaken earlier shall be performed by the parties until full completion unless agreed otherwise by both the parties in writing.

#### 5. Monitoring

At ANC, the Principal, will oversee the implementation of the MoU. At CTE, President/Secretary or his nominee will oversee the implementation of the MoU.

#### 6. Financial Provisions

- Total cost of the training will be recovered from the trainees and will be collected by ANC or CTE.
- Each Faculty/Resource persons will be paid honorarium as per the budgetary provision of training programme.
- TA/DA of all external faculties and other officials will be met from the training project cost.

\* A prior estimate of the activity will have to be approved by ANC

7. Amendments

This MoU may be amended and supplemented at any time by executing written agreement by both parties.

#### 8. Final Provisions

The parties consider this MoU as a declaration of intent rather than a legally or financially binding document on conducting trainings. They also proceed from the fact that nothing herein, therefore, shall diminish the full authority of either party to cooperate with third parties and conduct joint projects. This memorandum of understanding has been drawn up in two identical copies one can copy for each party.

  Government College, Bichhua, Dist- Chhindwara (MP), depending on the nature of work
  as per rules of the institute, facilities and requirements.
- Joint guidance of student projects in Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Sciences and other research
  areas of national interest on mutually agreeable terms.
- Endeavour the visits of students to Anand Niketan College, Warora, Dist. Chandrapur & Government College, Bichhua, Dist- Chhindwara (MP), to provide them with an exposure to various equipments, instruments, and study materials etc.
- Co-operate in Short term skill based and carrier oriented courses which can be a great way
  to improve upon ideas and skills and to provide opportunities to the students. Therefore, the
  above said colleges intend to co-operate and focus their efforts and co-operations within
  such areas.

The parties to this MoU undertake to treat as CONFIDENTIAL AND PRIVILEGED information of the other institution, which is so classified in advance. The terms of confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.

This MoU shall require the ratification of the competent academic/executive body of both the institutions.

- 1. In order to carry out the above activities, a detailed plan may be agreed to, upon consultation between the two institutions.
- 2. It is implicit that every activity undertaken under this agreement is approved by the appropriate officials at each institution and must fall within each institution's academic and fiscal constraints

3. This agreement will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid initially for 05 year period from that date unless sooner terminated, revoked of modified by mutual written agreement between tile Parties, and may be extended by mutual written agreement. However, termination of the MOU will not in any manner affect the interests of the students/faculty/scientists who have been admitted pursuing a programme under the MOU.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into by and between "Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology (VNIT), Nagpur, India" and the, "AnandNiketan College (ANC), Anandwan, Warora, India". The entities listed above may collectively be referred to as the parties to this MOU.

#### Article 1. SCOPE and PURPOSE

The main purpose of this MOU is to Promote an institutional linkage between VNIT and ANC and to explore avenues for possible collaboration in research and training of stakeholders broadly in the area Science, Engineering and Technology in which expertise exists and can be mentored by either or both of the two organizations.

#### **Article 2: DURATION**

This MOU will be in effect from the date of signing and remain in force until Three Years or until such time as proper notification, no less than 60 days in advance, is given by one or both of the parties of the intent to terminate or to modify the institutional relationship. The MOU may be renewed after three years depending upon the satisfactory review of progress/execution.

#### **Article 3: ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

Both parties agree on the followings:

- 1. To designate contact person(s) to facilitate the contacts and progress of the Work.
- 2. Implementing joint projects and sharing experiences:
  - i. To jointly prepare project proposals and submit to the relevant national and international funding agencies on mutually agreed subjects in Science & Technology to implement the approved projects by using capacities of both parties.
  - ii. To exchange faculty, experts and students for sharing knowledge and experiences forshorter or longerresearch visits.
- 3. Collaborate in education of students and young scientists:
- i. The respective faculty members of ANC and faculty members of VNIT will together formulate the syllabi for academic programmes, new courses, joint research projects and provide training for skill-oriented human resource development of the stakeholder within the areas of co-operation, faculty/research scholar exchange program, joint training programmes/ workshops etc.
- ii. The ANC may as well provide external guidance to two/three students at the B.Tech, M.Tech and/or M.Sc. level.
- iii. Summer/Winter Internship Program: This MOU will provide opportunities to the students of VNIT to pursue Internship Program at ANC and students of ANC will also get an opportunity for internship in VNIT Guest Faculty/Visiting Faculty: VNIT will invite experts from ANC to share their experience with students of VNIT by delivering lectures on a mutually agreeable topic, date and time.
- iv. Settlement of Dispute: Any dispute arising out of work related to this MOU will be settled through mutual discussion.
- v. Force Majeure: The parties shall not be held liable for any breach of terms and conditions under this MOU, when such breach results from a Force Majeure event. This MOU is not intended to create any legal obligations but rather is intended to foster genuine and mutually beneficial academic and research collaboration.

Separate agreements will be prepared and signed by both parties in case that a project proposal succeeds and receives funding. The exact terms and conditions of future co-operation mill be deliberated and documented in more specific national/international collaboration agreements.

#### **Financial Agreement**

This MoU is not committing any financial agreement between both colleges.

#### Amendment

- (1) This MoU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of both colleges, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MoU.
- (2) Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by both colleges.

# Entry into Force, Duration And Termination:

- (1) This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing.
- (2) This MOU shall remain in force for a period of Five (5) years and may be extended for another period of two (2) years by mutual written consent of the both colleges.

Whereas the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, constituted under the Company Secretaries Act, 1980 to develop and regulate the profession of Company Secretaries in India being solely authorized to conduct coaching and examinations for the award of Professional qualification / Membership of the Institute and whereas Anand Niketan College of Arts, Commerce & Science, Warora would create synergy between the university education and professional education to enhance the quality of education imparted to the ICSI students, the study centres proposed to be operated and managed by the Department of Commerce of Anand Niketan College of Arts, Commerce & Science, Warora will be set up on self-sustainable basis.



- Study centre shall function from the premises of recognized university/ college having proper recommendations of the concerned Regional Council/Chapter.
- 2. Study centre shall be run by faculty or Department of Commerce or any other department having relevance to CS Course, by whatever nomenclature, on self-sustainable basis as per ICSI guidelines.
- 3. The respective department of the university/ college shall operate and manage the ICSI study centre. Study centre shall in no case be termed as an agent or a partner or a representative of ICSI except for the limited purpose of providing class room teaching to CS students and other responsibilities covered in the agreement between the two Institutions.
- 4. Head of respective department of university / college in which the study centre has been set up or his representative will be designated as Director of the CS Study Centre.
- 5. Study Centre shall not engage itself any activity or deal with a matter which are prejudicial to the interests and image of the Institute
- 6. Study centres shall be entitled to use the words and description "ICSI (Warora) Study Centre"
- 7. The study centres would have full autonomy in deciding the fee to be charged from the students for the Class Room Teaching activity but the Institute would not provide any financial support/compensation to the study centres on any account.
- 8. ICSI Head Office/Regional Council/Chapter shall have no share in the revenue generated by respective study centres.
- 9. The Study Centre shall impart education with best faculty for various stages of ICSI Course Curriculum on the lines prescribed by ICSI.
- 10. The Study Centre shall conduct Career Counselling, suitably advertise and attract students for enrolment to CS Course and disseminate information regarding Company Secretaryship course.
- 11. Facilitating registrations to the CS Course through on-line mode. The Fee will be accepted by the Institute through online mode and the University/ College shall provide reasonable infrastructure (computer with internet connectivity, scanner, etc.) to enable the students to register online for CS Course. Students who are not having Credit/ Debit Cards may remit the fee through Bank Challan in which case cash can be deposited with designated banks (at present Canara Bank).
- 12. Provide at least one room space for ICSI representative office at University/ college campus.
- 13. Students of study centre shall be allowed access to the library of concerned department in which the study centre has been setup.



- 14. Members of Central Council, Regional Councils of ICSI or Members of the Chapter Managing Committees are not eligible to act as Faculty in the classes conducted by Study Centres.
- 15. The study centre shall submit quarterly MIS covering the activities conducted during such period like Details of Career Awareness Programmes/ Counselling Sessions conducted, Details of Registrations Facilitated(\*) with registration number, Details of Classes Conducted with registration number of the students etc. to the Regional Council/Chapter to which it is attached with a copy to the ICSI HQ.
- (\*) as per format decided by the Institute from time to time.
- 16. The college shall maintain a permanent display board, "ICSI Warora Study Centre" on the boundary wall of the college and also within the premises where the study centre is located.
- 17. The designated room shall be properly maintained with daily cleaning, proper lighting and whitewash.
- 18. ICSI shall share and suggest ways and means for effective conduct of classes by the centre
- 19. ICSI shall suggest / Depute faculty on specialized subjects as and when requested by the study centre
- 20. ICSI shall Assist in popularising the Class Room Teaching conducted by various study centres Study centre can advertise/publicise conduct of classes in the Institute's student e-bulletins "Student Company Secretary" and "CS Foundation Course" bulletin free of cost.
- 21. ICSI shall pay Honorarium as per the prevailing "ICSI Guidelines of Counsellors" of that day, for successful registration of students on receipt of quarterly MIS.
- 22. Apart from specific guidelines given above, general guidelines relating to conduct of class room teaching issued by the Institute are also applicable to the study centres as far as engagement of faculty, feedback, etc.
- 23. Faculty engaged for the purpose, as far as possible shall be in accordance with the guidelines and student teacher ratio should be 40:1 that is a maximum of 40 students per teacher.
- 24. The honorarium payable to the faculty members shall be decided by the study centres.
- 25. To the extent possible the faculty of the University/college shall be engaged to take the classes, subject to fulfillment of criteria.
- 26. Propagation of the schedule of classes through bulk SMS/ E-Mail among the concerned students will be through the Institute only and the same will be chargeable as per rates fixed by the Institute from time to time.
- 27. The Study Centre shall indemnify the Institute that the interests of the students will be protected at all times.
- 28. There would be at least one room for the representative office.



- 29. ICSI shall not pay any rent for the space provided by the University for the Representative Office.
- 30. The Director of study centre may engage any person at the representative office to register the students and render other administrative activities. Such person shall not in any way be treated as an agent or a partner or a representative or employee of the ICSI. No reimbursement of any type shall be made by ICSI for this arrangement.
- 31. The director of study centre shall engage and pay to the person engaged to register the students and undertake administrative functions of the study centre. No reimbursement of any type shall be made by ICSI for this arrangement.
- 32. The person to be appointed for manning the centre office to be from the institution, In order to have effective coordination with the college administration and to ensure access to the infrastructure facilities of the Institution as prescribed under these guidelines, to run the centre effectively.
- 33. Such study centre would be monitored and coordinated by Directorate of Student Services at Headquarters through the respective Regional Council / Chapter. ICSI shall keep a possible ordinary control to ensure quality of education through supervision by deputing its own personnel in the classes or having confidential or independent feedback from the students.
- 34. There would be a coordination committee having representative from the university/college and ICSI for monitoring the performance of the study centre at regular intervals, preferably every quarter.
- 35. ICSI shall not incur or suffer any kind of liability legal, financial or otherwise with regard to any obligations incurred by the study centre.
- 36. The officer as empowered by the HOD of Student Services or Secretary, ICSI or President, ICSI jointly or severally shall enter into an agreement between the respective University / college for setting up of Study Centre. 



The words "the two institutions" and "collaborating institutions" in the Memorandum of Understanding refer to the "Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Page 1 of 6

Warora" and "Luminescence Laboratory, PG Department of Physics, RTM Nagpur University Nagpur."

### Article-1: FIELD OF COLLABORATION:

Collaboration between the two institutions may be established within any field related to science and technology of mutual interest and in particular academics & research. Extension to other areas will be made through further amendments to the present Memorandum of Understanding.

### Article-2: EXCHANGE OF STAFF AND STUDENTS:

- 2.1 Faculty and students of either institute, who wish to undertake a short-term programme or field work/research work at the other institution, will be assisted by the host institution in getting authorization, finding accommodation, library and laboratory facilities provided the programme is accepted by the home institution and by at least one supervisor from each institution. Faculty and students should have funding for cost of daily living, accommodation, research costs, books, etc.
- 2.2 There is a possibility of twinning faculty and students of the two Institutions in common research.
- 2.3 Parties will exchange proposals concerning the topics, persons, type of research, tests and periods of specific research reasonably in advance of the proposed visit.

All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by XYZ during the course of this agreement shall be owned by the Anand Niketan College Anandwan, Warora. All intellectual property solely conceived and/or developed by "Luminescence Laboratory, PG Department of Physics, RTM Nagpur University Nagpur." during the course of this Agreement shall be owned by them. ### Article-1: FIELD OF COLLABORATION:

Collaboration between the two institutions may be established within any field related to science and technology of mutual interest and in particular academics & research. Extension to other areas will be made through further amendments to the present Memorandum of Understanding.

### Article-2: EXCHANGE OF STAFF AND STUDENTS:

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- 2.2 There is a possibility of twinning faculty and students of the two Institutions in common research.
- 2.3 Parties will exchange proposals concerning the topics, persons, type of research, tests and periods of specific research reasonably in advance of the proposed visit.

#### **Article- 7 FUNDING AND FINANCE:**

Information on research results and their application and scientific materials will be exchanged free of charge on returnable basis wherever possible.

### Article-8: LINK MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION:
