**Report on  
Faculty Development Program  
Rural Development: Opportunities & Challenges  
In association with CTE, Maharashtra Chapter & ISTD, Nagpur Chapter (04-08th  
October2021)**

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It was great to have you all with since this week for online Faculty Development Program on Rural development: Opportunities and Challenges, organized by Internal Quality Assurance cell (IQAC), Anand Niketan College of Science, Arts and commerce, Anandwan, Warora, in association with Council for Teachers Education (CTE), Maharashtra Chapter and Indian Society for training and development (ISTD), Nagpur Chapter.

We had three sessions per day each of 90 mins. Different speakers from various institutes and organizations has enlightened us with their ideas, experiences and knowledge. We are all obliged to have had you all with us this entire week.

**On day 1 i.e. 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021**, The FDP was inaugurated by Dr. Vikas Amte, Secretary, Maharogi sewa samiti Warora Anandwan followed by lectures conducted by **Dr. Prashant Wagh, DrDilipPeshwe and Dr. Yogeshwar Kalkonde.**

**Dr. Prashant Wagh**, Assistant Professor, Department of Botany, ANC warora, has shared his knowledge on need of Modern Farming techniques, his lecture was delivered with primary aim to make teacher fraternity aware about the skill based modern farming techniques developed as supplementary methods which can be implemented as alternative to present agriculture and will serve as future agriculture practices.

**Dr. DilipPeshwe, Professor**, Department MME, VNIT, Nagpur. He talked about atmanirbharbharat. He discussed various issues that are related to farmers and their solutions that can be helpful to them. He also discussed about various innovations like plastic dam, tire bridge, solar lanterns, cycle-o-cleaner done by his team in the field of agriculture, forests and various small villages.

**Dr. Yogeshwar Kalkonde**, Public health Doctor spoke on how higher education institutes can contribute in Rural Health and why it matters. He shared initiatives to help people out their in rural areas by empowering villages.

**For day 2 we had with Mr. Atul Sharma, Dr. Sachin Mandavgane and Mrs. Ratna Pandya.**

**Mr. Atul Sharma**, Trustee and Secretary, Gram sewa Mandal Gopuri, wardha shared his views on Bharat Jodo and khadi. He talked about history of khadi industry in India as well as contribution of Mahatma Gandhi in Promoting Khadi in India.

**Dr. SachinMandavgane** Associate Professor and head, Department of Chemical engineering, VNIT, Nagpur, shared with us the role of HEI's in rural development and few case studies. He



discussed waste utilization and ideas of his student like temple flower waste collection, orange peel utilization. Etc.

**Mrs. Ratna Pandya**, Treasurer, Center for environmental development, Wardhaspoke on food and agro products. She talked about product diversification using easily available plant products that can generate employment for people in rural areas.

**For day 3, Dr Sunil Mansinghka, Dr. Suhas Potdar and Dr Soham Pandya joined us.**

**Dr. Sunil Mangsinghka**, coordinator Go-Vigyan Anusandhan Kendra Deolapar talked about organic farming and importance of livestock in rural development. He discussed importance of cow in rural agriculture and various products that can be produced using cow dung and various cow products.

**Dr. Suhas Potdar**, Assistant professor, Anand Niketan College of Agriculture, Warora talked about geo informatics for resource characterization and mapping and management. He also shared with us how geoinformatics can play a crucial role to examine soil quality and design an action plan to provide reliable spatial information on various natural resources.

**Dr Soham Pandya**, Chairman Centre for environmental development, Wardha, talked about Appropriate technologies that can be implement in rural areas like mud housing, bamboo housing, flap seal toilet pan, biogas plant and many more for betterment of rural society.

**For Day 4 we had Dr. Nilesh Ugemuge, Dr. Satish Imade and Dr. Sushma Sharma to share their knowledge with us**

**Dr. Nilesh Ugemuge**, Assistant Professor ANC Warora highlighted different aspects of rural education. He has suggested various approaches to enhance quality of education.

**Dr Satish Imade**, Assistant professor Anand Niketan College of Agriculture Warora spoke on Agricultural Diversification for livelihood security of small farmers. He threw light on present agriculture scenario and issues to deal with this. He enlightened the need for diversification towards integrated farming.

**Dr. Sushma Sharma**, Principal, Anand Niketan School, Sewagram enlightened us with the actual meaning of education and defined it as the combination of mind, intellect and body. We will know what type of education to provide if we know what type of society we want, says Sushma sharma. She shared a practical approach of cooperative learning, integrated learning through gardening, spinning and stitching, kitchen works and various creative ideas for practical learning.

**For day 5 we have Dr. Ashok Belkhode, Dr Dilip Peshwe and Dr. Vijay Raibegkar.**

**Dr. Ashok Belkhode** Project director Sane, Guruji Rungnalaya Kinwat Spoke about Rural health Fact Challenges and solutions. In his lecture he has focused on the problems faced by tribal women related to gynec and unawareness of such issues in rural areas.

**Dr Dilip Peshwe Professor, Department MME, VNIT, Nagpur.** Talked about Biogas technologies for rural households and enlightened our knowledge with ready-made technologies available in market instead of old methods of biogas plants.

**Dr. Vijay Raybagkar Former professor and author of NCERT, Physics books.** Shares he knowledge about experimentation for rural development; he asked to come up with the ideas that are affordable, easy to handle and that should bring employment to people in rural areas.

This is how we were all privileged to be present here, to be a part to know about so many new techniques and ideas for rural development.
